Pentabus is the nation's rural theatre company, based in Shropshire. We are the only rural touring company that is committed to producing new work and tours to communities across the UK and beyond.

Our work brings communities and young people together, bringing outstanding contemporary productions with sector leading creative teams, directly to isolated rural communities, as well as platforming rural stories in urban settings.

Over five decades we've produced over 322 new plays, supported more than 135 playwrights and reached over half a million audience members. We've won awards and created lasting relationships with artists, venues and audiences across the country, and were the first to live stream from a village hall.

We excel at finding and nurturing new talent and have hosted Writers in Residences since 2014. These playwrights have gone on to be commissioned by the Birmingham Rep, Bristol Old Vic, Hampstead Theatre, HighTide, Manchester Royal Exchange, Nottingham Playhouse, Royal Court, The Bush, and the National Theatre.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The **Production Manager** will manage and oversee all production and technical elements of the production. Duties will include but will not be limited to:

- Managing and ensuring the successful implementation of all technical elements of the production; including set design, lighting, sound, costume, in liaison with the Producer and the design team.
- To create a production schedule.



- To support the set-up and running of the performances.
- To liaise with the venue regarding technical requirements as needed.
- To manage the production budget and ensuring no overspend.
- To manage the production so that it is realised within the constraints of the resources available, using Pentabus' stock of lighting, sound and AV kit and ensuring no hires are made.
- To line manage the Stage Manager in relation to production and technical issues.
- The Production Manager shall run the production meetings, sending agendas in advance and minutes after each meeting.
- Keep abreast of current developments in health and safety and ensure compliance with the requirements of the Theatre's Health & Safety Policy.
- To ensure that all aspects of the production are H&S compliant
- To run the technical rehearsals
- To lead the get-out after the final performance.
- To work with the Stage Manager to ensure that all equipment, set, props and costume are returned, and the rehearsal room and stores are left tidy.
- Support Pentabus' commitment to working in an environmentally and socially sustainable way. Utilising the Theatre Green Book as a toolkit to achieve the aims set out for the production.
- Support Pentabus' commitment to creating opportunity, particularly for marginalised and under-represented artists and freelancers by working in an inclusive manner.

### **Essential Experience**

- A minimum of 1 year's relevant professional stage management experience.
- Experience calling and oping theatre performances.
- Excellent people management skills.
- Proven ability to lead and communicate with creative and production teams.
- Ability to problem solve and stay calm under pressure.
- Ability to work flexibly as required.
- A sound understanding of planning relating to technical and production activities.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, a positive working attitude and a flexible nature.
